Books that are out of copyright (pre 1923) are available to read on a computer or ereader device free!



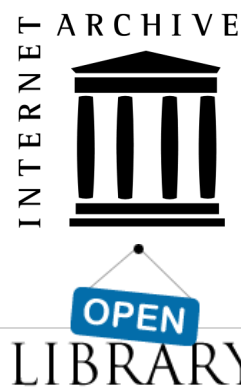
Project Gutenberg www.gutenberg.org

Project Gutenberg offers over 38,000 free ebooks: choose among free epub books, free kindle books, download them or read them online.

No fee or registration is required, but donations are accepted.

The Internet Archive www.archive.org/details/texts contains a wide range of fiction, popular books, children's books, historical texts and academic books.

Open Library openlibrary.org/subjects/lending_library is a project of the non-profit Internet Archive. Open Library's goal is to list every book -- whether in-print or out-of-print, available at a bookstore or a library, scanned or typed in as text. Download free books and texts.

Google Books books.google.com/advanced_book_search

At Google Books, use the advanced search option, choose a search term and select the "full view only" button to retrieve fulltext ebooks. If the books are in the public domain, you can download them in .pdf and oftentimes .epub formats (the ebook standard) for your e-readers, as well as download them using the Google ebooks app for your Android or iPhone/iPad.
