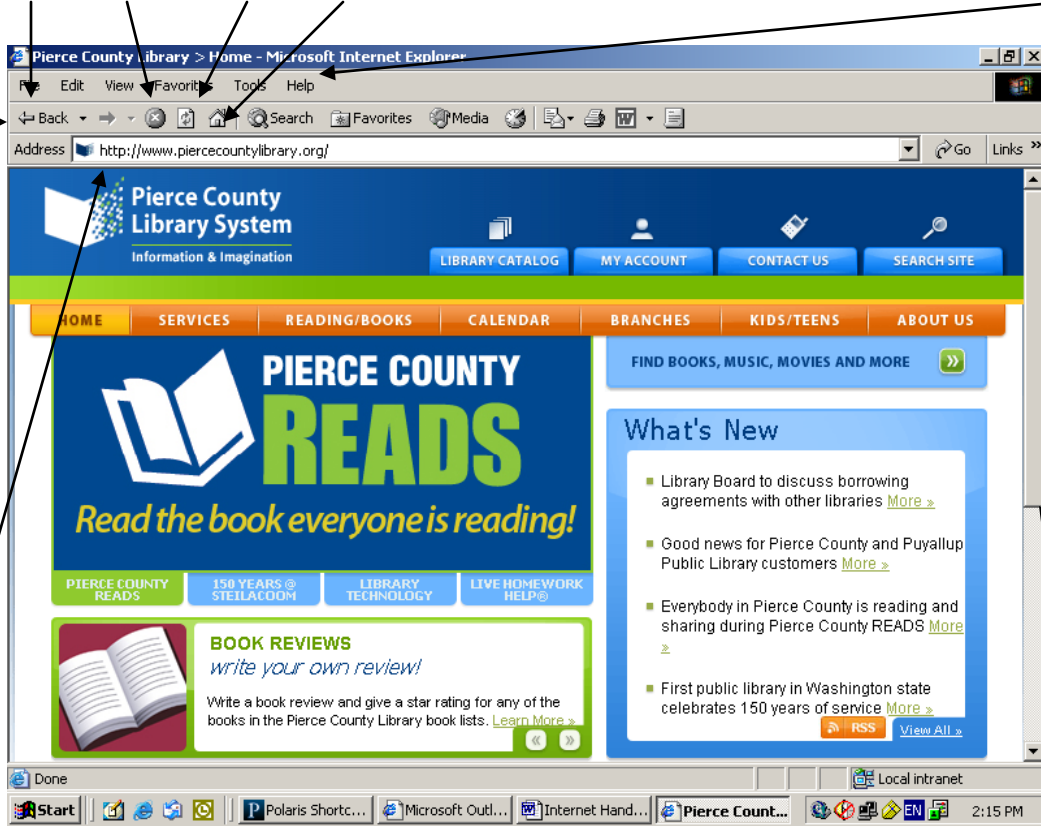


# Navigating a Web Page

## Tool Bar

The Tool Bar contains a series of icons. The Forward and Back arrow icons will reload previous web pages, the X in the circle icon will stop a web page from loading, the circling arrows icon will refresh the current page, and the house icon will take you to your computer's home page.

## Address Bar

The address bar displays the web address of the web site you are visiting. Type in a new address to visit a different web

## Menu Bar

The menu bar contains a selection of pull down menus such as: File, Edit, View, Favorites, Tools, and Help

## Sidebar

The Sidebar allows you to scroll through a web page. You can also scroll by clicking on the small arrows at the top and bottom of the Sidebar.

## Status Bar

The status bar indicates whether a web page has fully loaded.

## Cursors and Web Pages

As you move your mouse around a web page you will notice that it changes shape depending on what you're scrolling over.



Most of the time your cursor will be in the shape of an arrow. An arrow cursor allows you to click on buttons and select menus.



When your cursor changes into a hand with a pointed finger it means you've scrolled over a hyperlink. If you click on a hyperlink it will take you to a new page.



Your cursor will change into an "I" bar when you scroll over a box that wants you to enter text. Click in the box to add text.



When you see an hourglass next to your cursor it means the computer is attempting to perform a function such as opening a new page.
