Subject: County Comprehensive Plan Amendments

The County Council's vote on the 2011 Amendments to the Pierce County Comprehensive Plan has been rescheduled for Tuesday, October 18, 2011.

Originally scheduled on Oct. 4, the new date provides additional time for members of the County's Community Development Committee to consider potential amendments prior to making its recommendation to the Council. The Committee received public comment on proposed amendments during a public meeting held on September 19.

The Library submitted amendments that update existing and future library service elements in 11 community plans and address the Library's current recommended service level guidelines and individual recommendations for facilities and service improvements within each community. The Library's recommendations are a result of a variety of citizen input and involvement processes, including *Pierce County Library 2030: Facilities Master Plan*.

During the Board meeting I will update you on the County Council's decision. Approved amendments are effective March 2, 2012.
